## TEAM COMPOSITION AND ALLOCATION ... AND LAST-MINUTE ADJUSTMENTS!

Olympic round teams comprise **three archers**. Normally there would be four categories, but to deepen the match-play schedule at this event there were just **two divisions**: archers shooting recurve bows, and archers shooting compound bows. (Within each division, all archers competed together regardless of age or gender.)

To create as level a playing field as possible for the competition – and to make the team matches closer and more exciting – the organizing committee **allocated archers to teams** of roughly similar combined standard (based on their track record / anticipated 70m performance). Further rationale for this policy was that all entrants would have the opportunity to participate in a reasonably competitive team on the day, whether or not they had a chance to identify prospective team-mates in advance.

On the other hand, it means that last-minute changes in the number of competitors pose a logistical challenge for the organizing committee! Withdrawals and retirements necessitated **on-the-fly adjustments** to a number of the teams at this year's event. A brief summary follows:

Easily accommodated — because I knew about them well in advance — were several archers who wished to shoot the FITA 70m round but not the afternoon's team head-to-head. More problematic, however, were the unheralded **no-shows**, which had an impact on six teams. Although we were able to group most of the remaining team members into teams of three, we still found ourselves one recurve and one compound archer short — at which point work party volunteers were called on to make each division's final team up to a full complement. By this time the ranking round was under way and they could only shoot the second half, so for team seeding purposes their scores were doubled to account for this. (Another archer's score was similarly trebled, as he was only able to shoot one third of the ranking round.)

Further **retirements** at the end of the ranking round caused a few more team changes. In one case, an archer who had intended to shoot just the ranking round came back to fill the place left by one retiree. We learned of one final retirement after the teams had been seeded; fortunately there was just enough time to bring in another stand-by archer (this time from the GB Paralympic Squad staff).

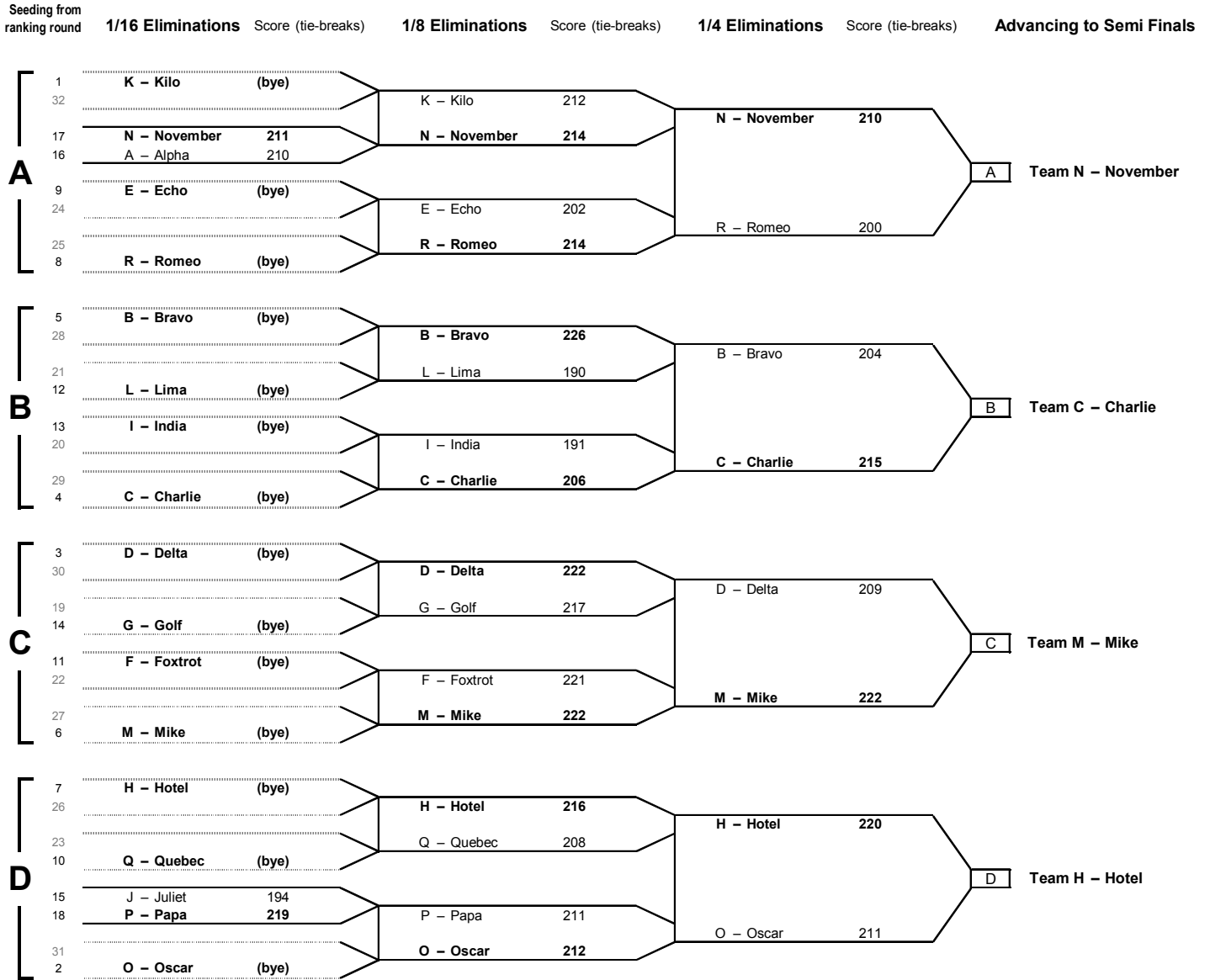

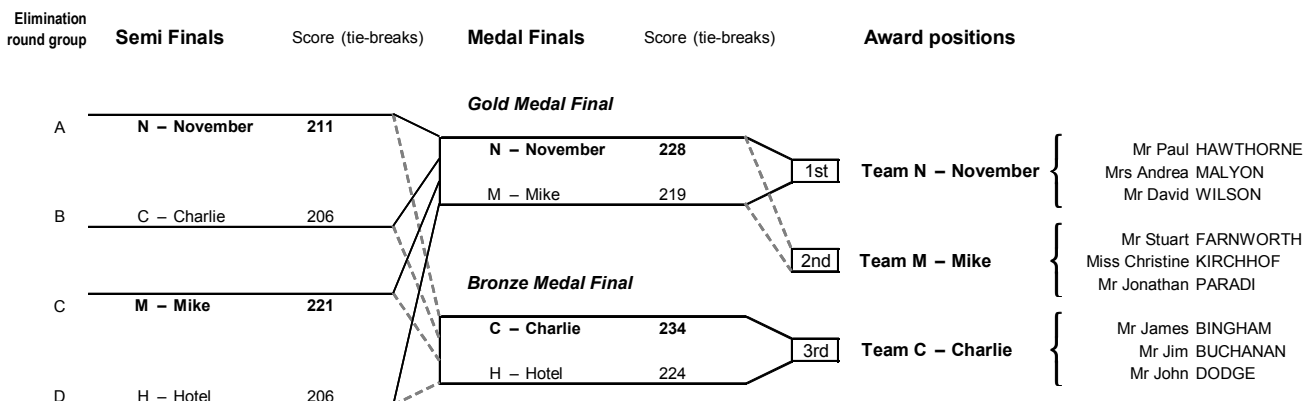

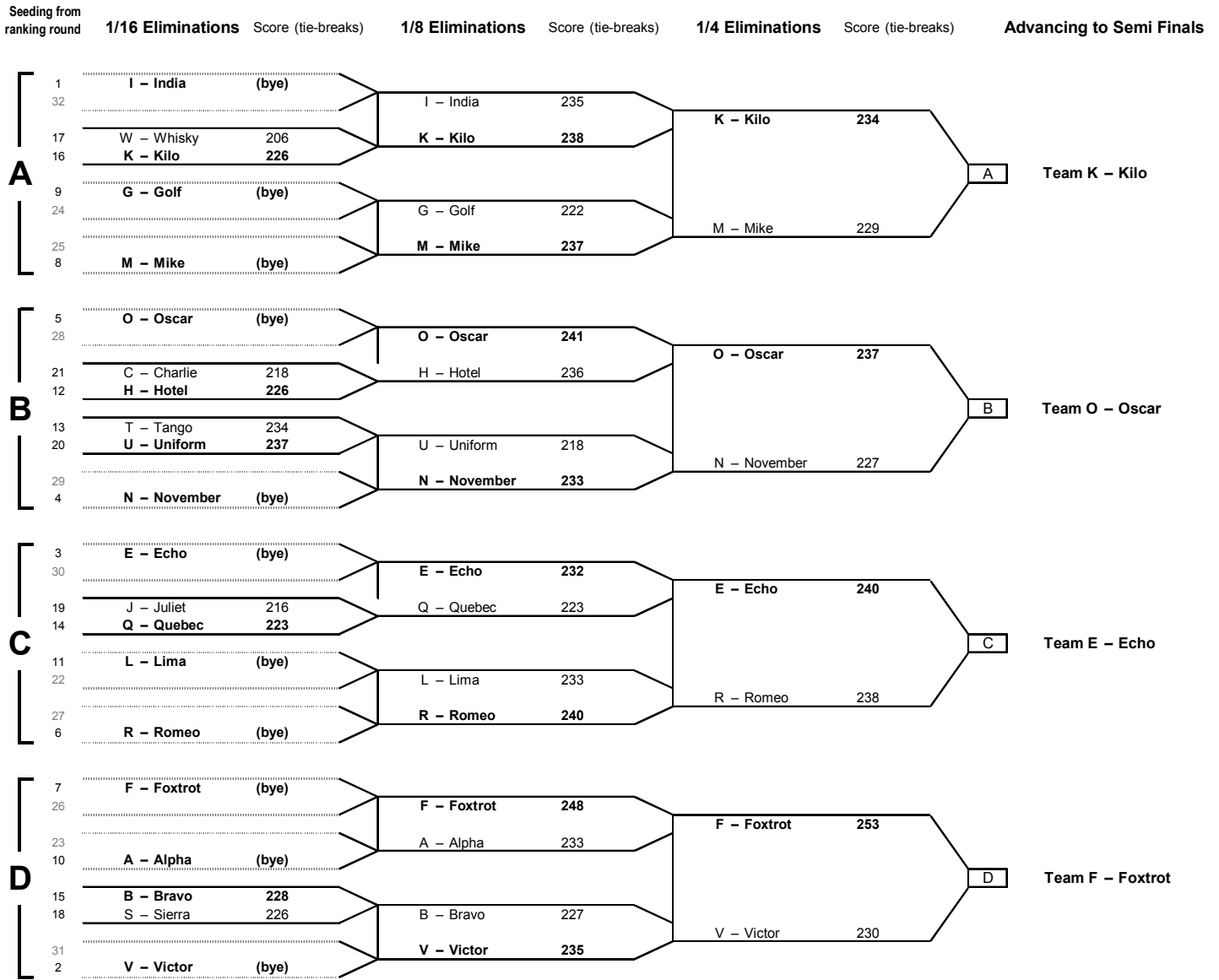
## OLYMPIC ROUND MATCHES (SEMI & MEDAL FINALS) – RECURVE TEAMS



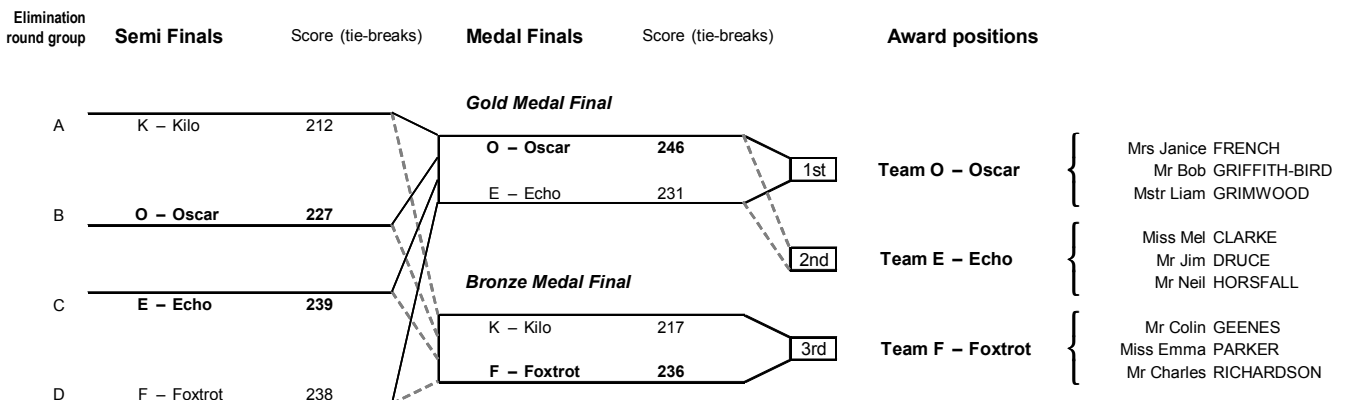
